

Government/Contractor Safety Incidents

- Incident, Serious Incident or Property Damage

Incidents pertaining to government employees and contractors.

-An incident is marked "serious" when death, dismemberment, or property damage exceeds \$150,000. Also, property damage is marked "recordable" when it exceeds \$2,000.

-A Form 3394 is created for all gov, lost time incidents.

Incident/Property Damage Process:

1. An Email sent to project verifier (s) for review. The verifier marks it as verified.
2. Emails are sent to coordinator and district personnel.

Serious Incident Process:

1. An Email sent to project verifier (s) for review. The verifier has 8 hours to verify or it is auto-verified.
2. Emails are sent to district, division, senior superiors.
