



FEDERAL HYDROPOWER STRATEGIC PLANNING WORKSHOP

HOOVER DAM TOUR 12 May 2008

What better way to get focused for the Federal Hydropower Strategic Workshop than to visit the iconic landmark for hydropower, Hoover Dam. An “insider’s” tour of Hoover Dam has been arranged for Workshop attendees. Please be sure to mark on the Registration Form that you will be attending the Hoover Dam Tour.

On 12 May 2008 we will meet in the lobby of the Circus Circus Hotel at 12:45. The tour bus will depart from the hotel at 1:00pm. Please arrive early and be ready to go so that we can depart on time. We expect about a 45 minute bus ride to Hoover Dam, with the tour starting at 2:00pm. The tour should take about 3 hours. The bus will depart Hoover Dam at approximately 5:00pm and we should be back at the hotel by 6:00pm.

Once we arrive at Hoover Dam, we will assemble in the Visitor Center Theater for a presentation, and then break up into smaller groups for the tour.

Some things to keep in mind for the tour:

- Hoover Dam is located in a desert climate. It is extremely HOT in the summer, and will likely be very warm the date of our tour. During summer months it is recommended that you wear light clothing and a hat, use sunscreen and sun glasses, and carry water bottles on the tour. Comfortable clothes and walking shoes are recommended.
- Food, chewing gum, canned drinks and drinks in cups are NOT allowed on tour or in the buildings. Water bottles are permitted.
- All visitors to the Visitor Center are required to enter the facility through a security checkpoint. Cameras, purses, and small-size backpacks are permitted. All carry-in possessions will be scanned.
